Exam Scope

Students should be able to:

- Answer questions on a reading comprehension text...
- Use and spell correctly vocabulary associated with geography and travel.
- Use regular and irregular plurals correctly.
- Spell and use regular and irregular simple past tense verbs and use these in the continuous form.
- Spell and use advanced descriptive adjectives in the comparative and superlative form.
- Know how to form and use compound sentences.
- Know past continuous vs past simple tense.
- Edit texts for capitalization and punctuation; spelling; tense; subject and verb agreement; singular and plural; comparatives and superlatives; conjunction; 'be verb'; and articles.
- Know how to write logical sentences and P.E.E. paragraphs.
- Identify and choose the correct past participle of regular and irregular verbs.
- Write persuasively
- Give reasons and details for opinions
- Complete a VENN diagram.
- Know how to read graphs, infographics, maps and Venn diagrams.
- Know if a statement is a fact or opinion, has pros or cons, and give reasoning for the choice.
- Know how to write and use nouns, verbs, adjectives, conjunctions, prepositions, and pronouns in complete sentences.
- Know how to use reflexive pronouns (myself, himself, herself, ourselves, themselves) correctly.
- Recognize some keywords to indicate which verb tense to use.

- Recognize and use pronouns.
- Answer reading comprehension questions based on geography.
- Be able to infer meaning based on a given text, common phrases, and visuals.
- Make text-to-self connections with details.
