Exam Scope

Students should be able to:

- Read a short story and answer comprehension questions.
- Use vocabulary about family, friends, and hobbies.
- Identify nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs, and prepositions in a text.
- Read a comic strip and complete a graphic organizer including the title, author, characters, setting, and sequence of events (plot).
- Fill in the blanks of sentences with the words *go*, *do*, *play*, and *have*, and complete complex sentences describing their own hobbies and interests.

Students will be marked on:

- Correctly answering comprehension questions.
- Ability to identify different parts of speech.
- Writing comparisons of hobbies and interests.
- Writing about their own hobbies and interests.
- Correct completion of a story elements graphic organiser.
- Using sequencing words correctly and in the correct order.
- Ability to use the correct forms of *go*, *do*, *play*, and *have*.
- Using correct punctuation, capitalization, spelling, and full sentences.
