Sectional Exam Term 2, Semester 1, 2024-2025

Exam Scope

Students should be able to:

- Correct use of term vocabulary, as well as spelling, punctuation, capitalization, and grammar.
- Reading a text and answering comprehension questions as well as identifying descriptive/informative words and phrases.
- Describe a photograph of Taiwan in the past and compare Taiwan's past to the present.
- Complete a bubble map fully and correctly.
- Write a caption for a photograph.
- Ability to write appropriate topic and concluding sentences.

Students will be marked on:

- Use and spell taught vocabulary about culture, traditions, and photography.
- Use and identify descriptive text features, as well as descriptive parts of speech.
- Read a short descriptive text and answer questions about it.
- Make connections between past and present Taiwan.
- Use a bubble map graphic organizer to plan and draft a descriptive text describing a photograph.
- Write a short descriptive text about a photograph with appropriate topic and concluding sentences.
- Use proper punctuation and capitalization, and write in complete sentences.
- Use taught grammar points correctly (e.g., *There is/There are vs. have/has*, subject-verb agreement).
